Refunds: To receive a refund the Rider must provide a Veterinarian or physician certificate at the start of the show for cancellations. Injuries occurred at show, certificates may be provided later. All fees will be refunded prior to closing date. After closing date a \$25.00 administrative fee will be deducted from fees paid.

Campbell River Trail Riders Rules

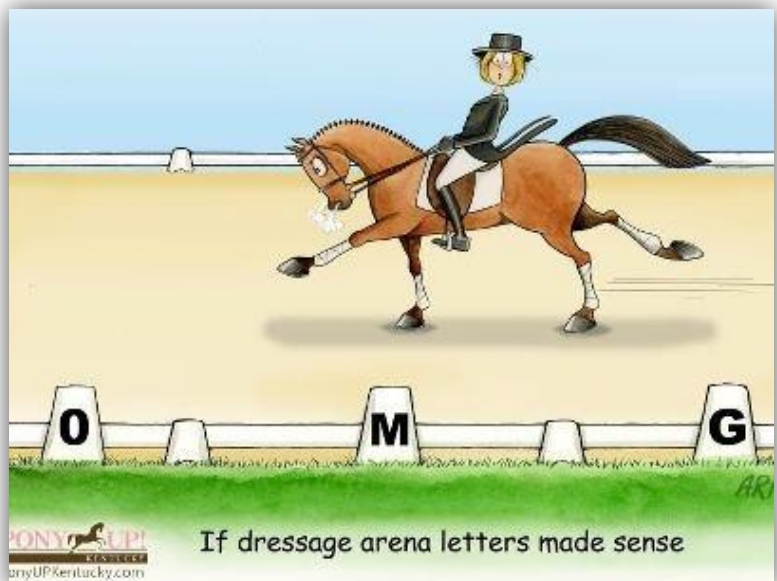
- The Campbell River Trail Riders supports adherence to humane treatment of horses in all competitions under its jurisdiction. The standard by which conduct or treatment will be measured is that which a reasonable person, informed and experienced in generally accepted equine training and exhibition procedures, would determine to be cruel, abusive, or inhumane.
- Horses demonstrating unsafe behaviour may be excused from ring.
- Every class offered herein is covered by the rules and specification of Equine Canada and will be governed in accordance with the current EC Rule book, Dressage, section C
- Any horse entered in any class at a competition subject to the requirement to pay drug testing fees may, while on the competition grounds and on the recommendation of the chair of the Provincial Equine Medication Control Committee, or the Chair's appointee, be selected for equine medication control testing.
- All entrants must belong to HCBC and hold a current EC sports license.
- All riders must belong to CRTR **before April 15th** of current year to be eligible for year-end awards.
- All members must help out at least one show during the show year.
- All members must be in good standing.
- Year-end awards are the same as champion divisions and over all points for the year for SR/JRA/JRB/JRC.
- Only one number/entry per horse/ridger combination, number must be worn and visible at all times.
- To qualify for points/prizes: rider must ride 2 different tests that day.
- Proper dress code is required.
- Proper behaviour is expected from all participants.
- Approved helmets must be worn at all times while in any riding rings.
- On show day the ring is closed until show begins.
- For the protection of competitors, dogs are not prohibited in barn and ring areas.

Dogs must be kept on leash at all times, while at the fairgrounds or privilege will be taken away, You Must pick up after your dog. Please keep dogs at camping area only.

- **Dogs are not permitted near barn areas or riding ring arenas at any time.**
- Reminder: any questions or concerns should be addressed to the officials in office.
- Protest must be submitted to the show office in writing with \$50 deposit (as per EC rules).
- Free style: riders please give CD or tape (rewound and ready to play) including instructions to the Entry Secretary or Announcer when picking up your Rider Number Package.
- Callers are permitted: riders are responsible for finding their own caller.
- Riders will be contacted by email or called approximately 1 week prior to the show date with your ride times.
- If you do not receive an email or a call within 3 days of show please contact Kathy Tipper by email at ertrbc@gmail.com Kathy checks for incoming email in the morning and evening.

Campbell River Trail Riders Rules Continued

- **In regards to prizes:** - gift certificates are at face value - must be redeemed within 3 months of date issued - prizes are not exchangeable.
- Awards: rosettes will be awarded to 1st - 3rd placing - double flat 4th - 6th placing.
- A minimum combined score of 55% must be obtained for champion and 50% for reserve champion for awards to apply. The highest combined total percentage of two different class tests at each level and category will be used as scores to determine champion and reserve champion.
- Freestyle scores do not count for high points. In the event of a tie, the rider with the highest single percentage is declared the winner.
- Rider must ride in two different tests to be eligible for champion and reserve champion awards.
- Division champion and reserve champions awards are based on the following schedule:
"Highest combined total percentage of two technical tests"
 - Walk/Trot level: Junior, Adult/Amateur
 - Training level: Junior, Adult/Amateur and Open
 - First level: Junior, Adult/Amateur and Open
 - Second level: Junior, Adult/Amateur and Open
 - Third level: Junior, Adult/Amateur and Open
 - Fourth level: Junior, Adult/Amateur and Open
 - FEI: Children, Pony and Junior – Combined
 - FEI: Young Horses
 - FEI: Young Riders
 - FEI: Prix St. Georges, Interned 1&2 and Grand Prix
- High point of show: each rider category are based on the following schedule - highest combined total percentage of two technical tests
 - Junior - Adult/Amateur - Open
- **FREESTYLE:** highest scoring freestyle
