Horse Show Office will be Open 1 Hour before the start of the show

- Pee-Wee 7 And Under Lead Line Classes
- Pee-Wee 9 And Under
- Youth 13 And Under
- Youth 14 To 18
- Senior 19 And Over

Proper Western Attire is required

- Boot-Cut Jeans
- Long Sleeve Shirt And Western Hat, Heeled Boots
- Chaps Optional In Riding Classes
- AMSI approved Helmet Are mandatory for youth

Riding Instructors actively coaching and riding their students horses in the show or warm-up arenas the day of show(s)

- Are Required To Show Their Current HCBC Membership Card For Insurance Purposes, To The Entry Secretary At The Office.
- Must have a Show number and sign wavier & pay administration fee for insurance purposes.

Non-Competitors must Pay Entries and have a show number

- Must advice the office of Non-Competitor status and turn number over.

The Show Committee reserve the right to combine classes for lack of entries

- CRTR reserve the right to excuse lame and sick horses form show, refunds will be given at the discretion of the show committee.

Stabling: Competitors with stalls or paddocks are responsible for completely cleaning stall or paddock before leaving grounds.

- if your stall is left unclean your "Stall Deposit" cheque will not be returned

Over Night Camping is FREE to those who are entered in the show

All Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times and must not go beyond designated areas

- No Exceptions, No Excuses - This is for competitors and spectators safety

Proper Equipment:

- Junior Horses are age 5 and under / senior horses are 6 and over.
- Junior horses permitted (not mandatory) any of the three following options:
 - A snaffle bit
 - The Bosal, used two handed
 - A Leverage Bit, used with one handed only. Pee-Wee classes are exempt from this rule
 - Western Performance Green Horse/Green Rider first year showing, Lope any age horse may use two-handed Snaffle or Bosal, but must use one handed Leverage bit, Peeweess may use two handed Leverage bit, Snaffle or Bosal
