CRTR Members Drop-In Expectations at Equestrian Centre Monitored Daily

- Use of the CRTR Equestrian Centre for members is on the **"honor system"** and will be removed if abused. All members must follow our Riding Ring Rules.
- Use of the CRTR Equestrian Centre is on a "First Come, First Serve" basis. This method has worked successfully in the past and we thank our members for their cooperation in using our facilities. For this reason we do not have a formal members riding ring schedule, other than our schedule of events, which are listed here at the website and will also be posted at our facility.
- The CRTR Equestrian Centre is for Personal Use Only.
- There will be equipment designated for Drop-In use only: jumps/poles some western equipment and Dressage letters. (Will be set aside for use)
- If the ring is in use please use the warm-up ring, or ask if you may join them into the ring.
- Private lessons are allowed for members. All instructors must carry their own insurance coverage /HCBC and copies must be provided to CRTR.
- Clinics put on through an organizer not through CRTR must pay a club fee. All instructors must carry their own insurance coverage / HCBC and copies must be provided to CRTR.

- Please do not use Kitchen, Sprinklers or Announcers Stand unless pre-arranged.

IMPORTANT NOTICE TO PARENTS/GUARDIANS OF MINORS USING THE CAMPBELL RIVER EQUESTRIAN CENTER
